Body of the Paper

The text of the actual book review should be no longer than **3-5 pages**.

The main text format should be Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5 spaced, justified.

Ideally, each book review should have an introduction, body, conclusions and bibliography. The body of the paper may be divided into sub-sections, but no more than 5, or it may be unitary. Use a one-column format.

Please do not add any text to the headers or the footers. The page numbers should be inserted on the right side.

1. NEW SECTION/SUB-SECTIONS

The heading of each section should be written in Times New Roman, small CAPS, 12, left justified, bold. Please use numbers (1, 2, 3 and so on) for the sections' numbering and leave one blank line of 12 above each new section. Subsections should be numbered 1.1 /1.2 and so on, and should be separated from the previous text by one blank line of 10 above each sub-section.

Please use footnotes according to the guidelines below. Authors are responsible for ensuring that the information in each reference is complete and accurate.

Please note that references to the book you are reviewing should be integrated simply into the text, just by page (**p. 313**), for example.

For any additional text related issues, please consult the Chicago Manual of Style.
